

## By Road

Bedford School is perfectly positioned for travel by road.

#### From London and the M1 Motorway

Leave the M1 motorway at junction 14 and join the A4258 which leads to the edge of town

### From the North – Wellingborough and the A6

Enter the town along the A6, turning left into Roff Avenue at the roundabout with Tavistock Street and Union Street.

From the East – Cambridge and the A1
Turn off the A1 on to the A421, later joining the A428 at the roundabout on the outskirts of Bedford.

The A428 runs into Goldington Road, then turn right into Polhill Avenue.

# By Rail 😂

- Bedford Railway Station offers excellent links into London.
- London St Pancras International is just 39 minutes, with trains every 10 minutes at rush hour and two fast trains every hour.

## By Air 🐼

- London's international airports are easily accessed by both road and rail from Bedford.
- Trains run directly from London Gatwick Airport.
- The Piccadilly line, on the London Underground, connects St Pancras International with London Heathrow Airport.
- London Stansted Airport is about 75 minutes away by road, and London Luton Airport is just 15 minutes by rail and 40 minutes by road.
