Scissors is the third play in a trilogy by Chris Bush called Rock/Paper/Scissors, premiered in Sheffield in 2022. The 'Rose Bruford version' is an adaptation of the original Scissors, including a number of scenes from Rock and Paper. With their subtly different textures, each play in the trilogy depicts the same characters in three different locations in the factory - a small workshop space; the abandoned factory floor; and a dingy office.

The drama in the play revolves around a single scissors factory in Sheffield where the owner - Eddie - has died. A succession crisis ensues: will Eddie's sister, daughter, the factory manager or apprentices be given a chance to take over? Each has a competing interest, a competing vision.

Underneath the text - and at times at its surface too - is the theme of the climate crisis. Isn't the climate crisis also a struggle over competing visions for how our world can/should be inhabited? As climate scientist, Professor Jem Bendell, suggests, the world needs a 'deep adaptation', which means letting go of what seems normal to us now. To accept what is already lost. To fight for what little can be saved. In a truly Chekhovian way, the characters in *Scissors* fight over what to do with the factory, while the world around them burns.

The creativity and energy of the ensemble I have been fortunate enough to work with on this production - actors, designers, production and stage management teams - has been a gift that I'll remember fondly.

A special thanks to the cast for throwing themselves into the ensemble work from day one (in a mere three and a half week rehearsal period) - with Lucy and Matty supporting me as assistant directors and every single member of the company contributing music - created in the rehearsal room - to Ellis' sound design as well as devising physical images towards the language of the production.
