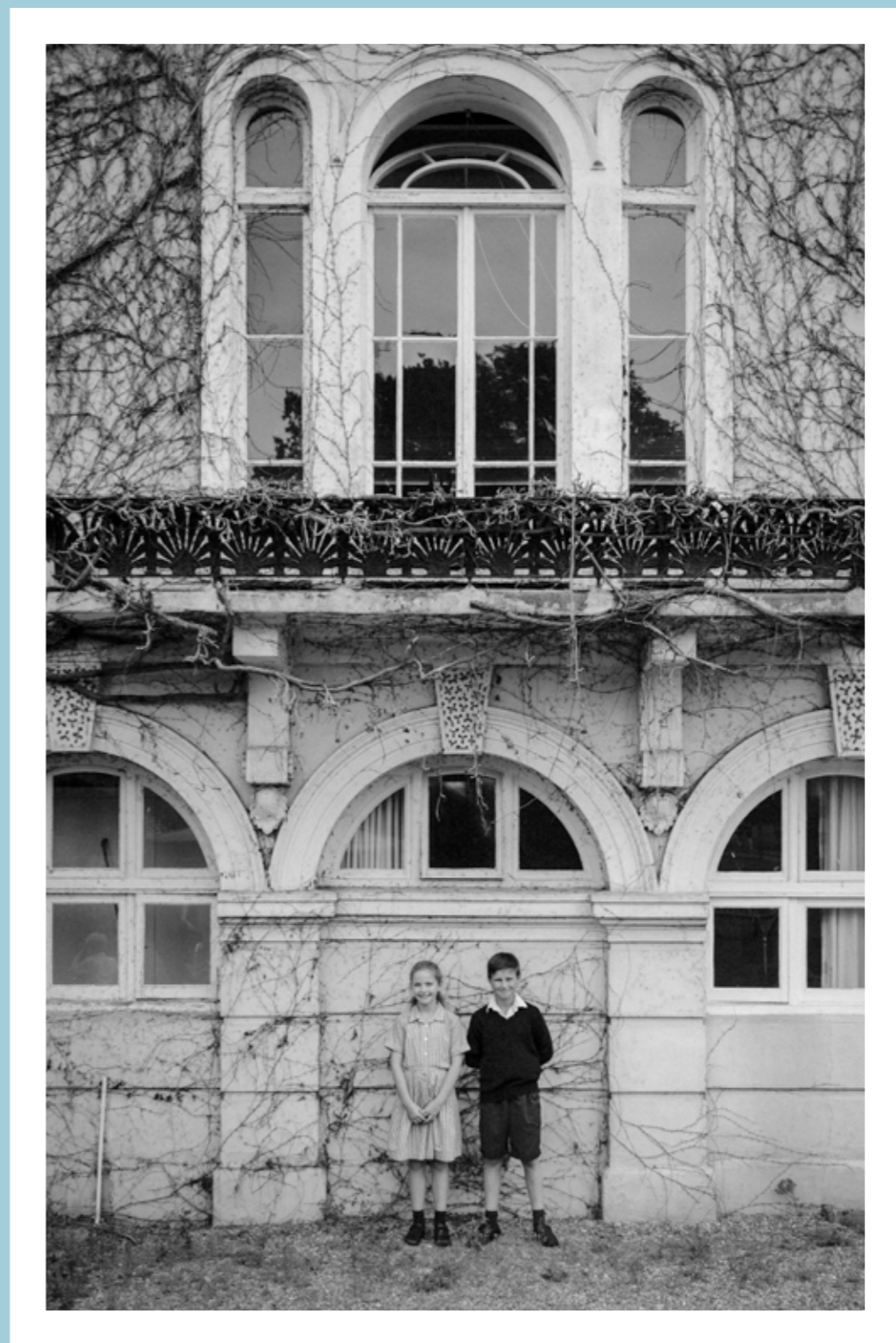

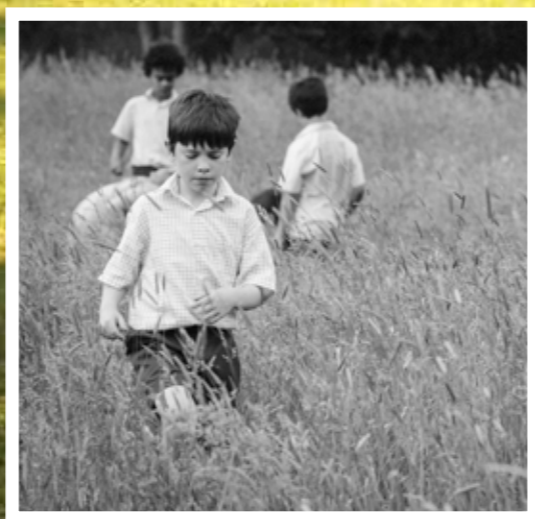

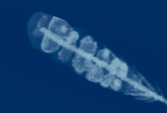




Sport



Sport is not the preserve of those who are blessed with innate ability; it's an essential 'feather' in a child's development. We offer an extensive list of sporting activities and countless competitive fixtures to ignite their enthusiasm and inspire them to success.





We are proud of the extent to which our children embrace Sport at Lambrook, learning the lessons that will serve them in their adult lives: to understand their part and respect that of others in a team, to always play their best whether they represent the A or F squads, and to know that defeat or victory should be faced with grace and humility.

With over 1,000 fixtures a year, every child, whatever their aptitude for sport, will have a chance to play competitively and feel part of a sporting team. Boarding



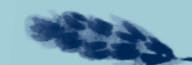
Our boarding welcomes children into a close-knit family, fostering their independence, developing their social skills and providing the environment and facilities to grow into confident, healthy and happy young adults.
