

### **Charges for all-inclusive short stay boarders 2026-2027**

Short-stay boarders can join St Andrew's Prep for a minimum length of half a term, into Years 5 to 7. Please note that Year 8 pupils must stay for one whole term, or longer. Short stays can join the school in any term, subject to availability.

#### **Admissions Process**

The first stage of the admission process is to complete and return a registration form (available [here](#)) to reserve a place for your child at St Andrew's. There is a non-refundable registration fee of £190. A deposit of £1,000 is required to confirm the place. This is to cover any extras incurred during the stay and is credited on the final bill at the end of term. Any credit balance will be refunded. The registration fee, deposit and full tuition and boarding fee are payable on receipt of invoice before a child enters the school.

#### **Basic Boarding Fee at £1,550 per week (inclusive of VAT) will include:**

- Full facilities as a boarder including tuition, extra English lessons, board and lodging and participation in the whole school community.
- Weekend trips
- Activities including after-school and Saturday morning\*
- School outings as part of the curriculum
- Weekday and weekend tuck
- Birthday parties with a cake
- General text and exercise books
- Dry cleaning and haircuts
- Taxis to dental or doctor appointments

*\*Some activities are chargeable*

#### **Extra English tuition (inclusive of the fees)**

The pupils are taught in small groups by a specialist teacher. Extra English tuition for children in is given in place of Latin and Spanish (Year 7 and 8 only). They will receive French tuition if deemed appropriate.

#### **Meals**

All meals are included. These comprise of breakfast, mid-morning snack, lunch, afternoon snack, and supper. A sample menu is available [here](#) on our website.

#### **Sport**

Sport plays an important part of the curriculum at St Andrew's and may include:

Michaelmas term: Rugby (boys), Football (boys), Hockey (girls), Netball (girls), Swimming, Gym, Tennis, PE

Lent term: Rugby (boys), Football (girls), Hockey (boys), Swimming, Gym, Tennis, PE

Summer term: Cricket, Athletics, Swimming, Gym, Tennis, PE (all both boys and girls)

*Please note: PE (physical education) lessons include athletics, basketball, badminton, dance, gymnastics, handball, swimming, tennis, volleyball, water polo, water lifesaving and personal survival on a rotation basis.*

### Activities

St Andrew's offers a comprehensive range of extra-curricular activities in the Prep school. The programme is based on staff's interests and expertise, and it gives the opportunity for staff and children to share mutual enthusiasms. For Years 5 to 8, activities and Prep (homework) is timetabled on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday afternoons from 4.10pm until 5.30pm. There is also the option to choose a further activity after school (5.30pm until 6.15pm) followed by supper.

Most activities on offer are inclusive of the fees. However, where an activity requires specialist equipment or is led by an external teacher, a small charge may be made. Any extra charges incurred will be added in arrears (at the end of the term). A sample of the extra-curricular programme is available [here](#).

### Communications

Parents will receive a weekly email and newsletter for the duration of their child's time at St Andrew's Prep. There is also a termly calendar available on our website. A link will be sent in the new pupil information pack.

### Extras

*The following is a guideline of extras not included in the fees which may be incurred during a child's stay. Any extras are charged in arrears and will be deducted from the deposit held by the school:*

- School photographs (optional)
- Music tuition (optional – see below)
- Residential trips (optional and where relevant)
- Badges for sporting achievements and positions of responsibility etc
- School uniform (see below)
- Pocket money (see section below)

### Pocket Money

The Head of Boarding will distribute an appropriate amount of pocket money on a weekly basis, and the amount will be added to your bill. Please do not send your child with large amounts of cash, ideally no more than £180 for a full term.

### School Uniform

St Andrew's Prep pupils wear a school uniform which can be purchased via our online suppliers [Schoolblazer](#) and [PlayerLayer](#). New uniform purchased can be returned to the school at the end of a child's stay and a refund, generally 25% for items in good condition, will be made. We also offer a rental scheme. For £130 a term the package will include all day uniform and sports kit required while the children are at the school. The hire does not include any footwear, mouth guards, or sports equipment such as tennis racquets and hockey sticks. A list of uniform requirements and a price list are available on the School's website. All clothing must be named. If purchasing uniform from new, both

online suppliers provide a naming service which you can select when you checkout. Alternatively, if hiring second-hand uniform, we will provide generic name tapes for each item of clothing.

### **Music Lessons**

Further details are available on request and lessons are subject to availability.

### **Transport**

We can arrange transfers to and from airports and stations with a reliable service at an extra charge. All drivers are known to the school and have carried out the correct safety and police checks. Please request further details if required.

### **Guardianship**

It is a condition of entry to St Andrew's that children without a parent resident in the UK must delegate parental responsibility to a suitable guardian who is aged over 25 and living in the UK. The selection of a guardian is the responsibility of the parent. However, we can provide names of guardianship agencies who are either accredited or affiliated to AEGIS and whom we currently use. ### **Exeat Weekends and Half Term Holidays**

All children, day and boarding, leave the school premises during an exeat weekend (long leave – no school Saturday or Sunday) and during the weeks of half term. There are generally two exeat weekends and one-half term each term. It is the responsibility of the parent to plan with the appointed guardian for exeats and holidays. In the case of an appointed AEGIS agent, the company will make all the necessary arrangements.

### **Insurances**

Pupils will need to have an UK Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC) before they travel to the UK to cover medically necessary healthcare provided by the NHS which cannot reasonably wait until they return to their home country. This is not a substitute for travel insurance, and you should make sure that you have this in place as well which should also cover any personal effects. Further information is available [here](#).

### **Medical information**

Parents will need to provide full medical information about their child prior to their joining the school. This must include full disclosure of any medicines which have been prescribed by a doctor. A consent form will be sent with the new pupil joining pack.
