This week the children have been writing cards for "Guess My Insect". Here are some below. Can you guess the insect:

I have no eyes and no legs. I live in the soil. What am I? (worm)

I can fly. I have long legs. I eat bugs. What am I? (cranefly)

I can fly. I live by the pond. I have wings. What am I? (dragonfly)

I can fly. I have beautiful wings. I used to be a caterpillar. What am I? (butterfly)

I have up to 314 legs. I eat insects. What am I? (centipede)

We have also been sewing and watching our plants grow, with great excitement.

In Maths this week we have been writing teen numbers, saying 'ten one, ten two, ten three, ten four, ten five' etc. to help with writing them. We have also been counting in tens, hearing the difference between the ty numbers (30, 40 etc) and the teen numbers (13, 14 etc). We would love to see their solutions for the problem below, via Tapestry.

She stopped for a rest after writing seventeen digits (not numbers!). What was the last number she wrote?
