Junior Maths Challenge Results 2019

The results for the **National Junior Mathematics Challenge** have now arrived in school, and they make great reading. It is one of our best ever set of results since we started entering in 2001 with the second highest number of certificates being awarded out of the largest entry we have ever had, 106 students.

Sixty-four pupils in Years 6, 7 and 8 have been awarded a certificate, including 11 Gold awards. Five pupils have also been invited to take part in the Junior Kangaroo Round and one pupil has progressed through to the Junior Maths Olympiad round. These are extra papers that will be sat next week by those that have scored highly across the country.

Best-in-School, and going on to the next Olympiad round, is Juliette B; and those doing the kangaroo paper are Harry TB, William M, Daniel M, Theo W and Constanze T.
