This week our focus has been on Chinese New Year, where our New Year celebrations began with role play in the Chinese restaurant; woollen noodles and chop sticks were among the play resources in use. The children have had the opportunity to explore how to write Chinese letters, to make hand held dragons, Chinese drums and enjoy making animals with tangrams. We located China on a world map and performed a simple dragon dance! Many thanks to Mrs Xu (mother of Siqi, FCH) who came to share a story about Chinese New Year with FCH and gave the children lanterns to make and Mrs Moses (mother of Sebastian, FCB) who gave the children fortune cookies.
