### **Mascot personality**

### **ENTERING THE COMPETITION**

- 1. Entries must be submitted to **Mrs Linda North by Friday 15**<sup>th</sup> **May 2020** who will forward a scanned copy of the design to the IAPS competition organisers.
- 2. The entry should be accompanied with the following information:
  - Mascot Name
  - A brief description about the mascot you have designed and its personality.
    (Up to 200 words max)
- 3. The shortlisted designs will be judged by a panel made up of IAPS members and staff.
- 4. Six entries will be shortlisted before the winning design will be announced at the start of the academic year (September 2020).
- 5. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place designs will be awarded a prize.

### COMPETITION RULES

- 1. To take part, schools must be a full member of IAPS.
- 2. The entry must be made by a child who attends an IAPS member school.
- 3. Entries must be made by a child aged between 4 and 13 years.
- 4. Only **one design** per child will be accepted.
- 5. There is no limit on the number of entries per school.
- 6. Once a design has been submitted, it cannot be edited or altered. You cannot withdraw your entry in favour of another piece.
- 7. Entries should be submitted by email by the school. Digital photos or scanned artwork should be attached, along with submission of the entry form.
- 8. Photographs of artwork should be of the artwork alone. People should not be visible holding the work or standing next to it.
- 9. Entries must meet the design brief, as attached.
- 10. In entering, schools and parents accept that winning entries will be used on the IAPS website, social media pages and in any in-house literature free of charge (N.B. the catalogue of winners and runners-up may be sent outside the UK).
- 11. IAPS will have the copyright for all designs submitted for the competition.
