

Yer 7 Hindu Gods Top Trumps Cards

Avatars: lots, including the monkey god, Hanuman.


Consort: Parvati, goddess of love.

Animal: Bull, representing power.


Symbols: three eyes, all seeing, dancing on a dwarf demon, power again.




